Guidelines for Returning/Donating Seeds

- Please make sure seeds are dry and clean.
- Only return seeds from plants that you know how to save properly. Beginner (green) seeds can be fairly reliably saved without cross-pollination. Moderate (yellow dot) seeds can be saved with a minimal seed saving knowledge. Advanced (red dot) seeds should only be returned if you have taken the appropriate steps to prevent cross-pollination.
- Label your seeds properly and provide as much information on the seed donation form as possible.
- Fill this form out, attach it to your sealed seed envelope or container and drop it into the Seed Donation box at the Seed Library.
