Mobile Hotspot Checkout Guidelines

- St Johns County Public Library System (SJCPLS) now has Kajeet Mobile Hotspots available for checkout.
- Hotspots contain a mobile wireless MiFi device, a charging cable and power unit, a carrying case, and an instruction card.
- Hotspots may be checked out for 21 days at a time.
- Devices are first come, first served with no holds or renewals, or re-checkouts to the same household within 48 hours of return. One device at a time may be checked out per household.
- Patrons must have a Resident or paid Non-resident card, be 18 years of age or older and have a library card in good standing.
- A \$1.00 a day late fee will be charged for overdue hotspots.
- WiFi service will be disabled at the end of the loan period and device must be returned. The late fee will continue to accrue until the hotspot is returned, even if the service is suspended.
- Devices must be returned in person to the same library branch where they were checked out and may not be returned in the bookdrop.
- Replacement cost for mobile hotspots is \$100. Cable or brick replacements are \$10 each.

Patron Checkout Agreement

By borrowing and initiating use of the St. Johns County Public Library System's mobile hotspot, the user agrees to abide by the library's policies, agrees to hold SJCPLS and its agents harmless from any and all claims, losses, damages, obligations or liabilities, directly or indirectly, relating to the use of the SJCPLS hotspot and associated internet access. Deliberate altering of any files or modifying the configuration of library-owned equipment is strictly prohibited, and may result in the loss of hotspot borrowing privileges.

Internet Service outside of the United States is prohibited. Any fees associated with misuse will be the borrower's responsibility. The borrowing patron will be responsible for lost or damaged hotspots and accessories (including theft). Hotspots must be kept in a temperature-controlled environment and not left in vehicles or in extreme temperatures.

Parents and guardians are responsible for use of hotspots by minors.
