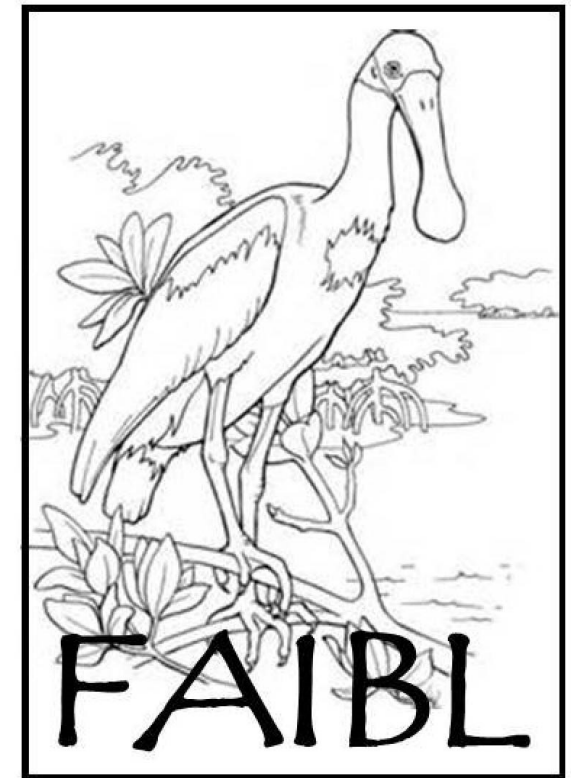
### Anastasia Island Branch Library

The library reading app



Borrow ebooks, audiobooks, magazines, and more from your local library for free! Libby is the newer library reading app by OverDrive, loved by millions of readers worldwide.

## Getting started with Libby

Libby is made possible by your local library and built with ♥ by OverDrive.

1. Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android or IOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch) device. Or, visit [libbyapp.com](http://libbyapp.com) in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser. Libby is not available on Kindle devices.
2. In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
3. Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** (  ) and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

On your **Shelf**, tap **loans** at the top of the screen. From there, you can:

- Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle (U.S. libraries only) or Libby.
- Tap **Open In Libby**, **Open Magazine**, or **Open Audiobook** to start reading or listening in the app.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew** and **Return**.
